Year 3 Children may choose up to **three** activities after school.

Year 2 Children may choose up to **two** activities after school. This does not include Yogatots.

Year 1 Children may choose Yogatots, Ballet, Playball or African Drumming, maximum of **two** after school.

Reception Children may choose Playball.

After 29th March, if there are spaces in an activity club, Year 2 and Year 3 children may choose an additional club.

When choosing clubs, please bear in mind any other commitments your child has during the school day, such as individual music lessons or extra tuition, as this can lead to some children having a very long day with few breaks. Year 2 and 3 also have homework commitments during the week, and may need to practise their instruments.

We will try and accommodate your requirements, but numbers for each club are limited. Priority will be given to Year 3 children with special consideration being given to their first choice.
