# Sports overview

Sport at Bedales has continued to grow and develop over the last 10 years, with a greater emphasis placed on student performance both individually and within team sports.

Within the last year, sport provision has been significantly reviewed which has had a direct impact on the school timetable allowing students to be taught in single sex ability groups, and be assessed according to national levels. At U14 (Block 3) and U15 (Block 4), all students take part in eight lessons of physical activity per week.

This year 36 different sports have been provided ranging from football and netball to horse riding and aikido. School teams have performed well, and are now taking part in county, regional and national competitions for all ages across a range of sports.

From September 2011, a new sports kit designed by the Sports department will be introduced to students at the prep and senior schools and phased in for all students over the next year.

The Block 4 students have had a good year with a number of students showing excellent progress in individual and team sports. The girls have played fixtures in hockey, netball, rounders, athletics, football and tennis, whilst the boys have played fixtures in football, rugby, hockey, tennis, athletics and cricket. 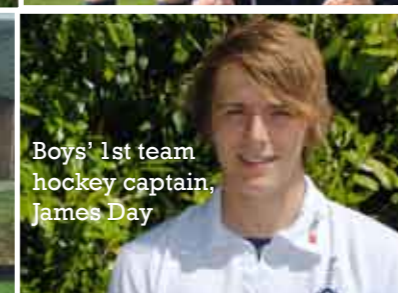
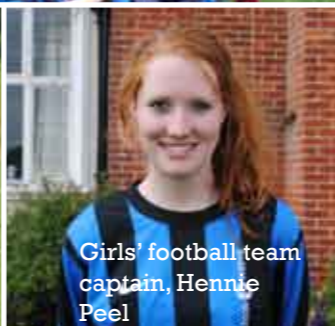

# Senior Sport

The senior teams are made up of Blocks 5, 6.1 and 6.2 students. In the majority of sports, we run two to three squads. The major sports played by the seniors this year were hockey, football, netball, rugby, tennis and cricket. The girls' and boys' hockey teams both performed well at the Hampshire Schools hockey tournaments, the girls' netball team also participated in the Hampshire Tournaments. The U18 rugby team performed well in the Hampshire Schools competitions for 15 and 7 a side. In tennis the school entered the National Aberdare and Glanvill Cup, with the boys' team reaching the 3rd round this year. The 1st team football squad will be having a pre-season training tour in Villareal during the summer vacation, ready for the new season in September. The team has been entered into the ISFA National Boodles football competition.



# Sports day 2010

Sports day in 2010 was an exceptional day with great weather and some great performances to match. The best girls' track event was awarded to Augusta Scott for her performance in the 800m, best girls' field event went to Freya Deane who broke the school record for the discus. The best track performance for boys went to Tao Peskett for the 100m and best field event for the boys went to Elliot Smart who also broke a school record for the triple jump.



# Range of Activities

Over the last year, the sports provision in evening activities, has increased significantly. The students have been able to continue with core sports such as football, hockey, netball, cricket, tennis, rounders, rugby, but have also been offered fencing, aikido, karate, trampolining, street dance, table tennis, basketball yoga, swimming, aerobics at the fitness barn, water aerobics, bouldering and climbing at the Alton centre, horse riding, squash, sailing, and use of the school multi-gym for cardiovascular and muscular strength programmes.



# Bedales Outdoor and Adventurous Activities (OAA)

OAA is an area of sports education that provides both individual and team challenges to all students. Block 3 students experience a week in Ullswater providing a great opportunity to test themselves in a variety of activities including rafting, sailing, climbing and hill walking.

In Block 4, as part of the weekly sports programme in the spring term, students attend the Peter Ashley Centre at Fort Purbrook, where they take part in archery, rifle shooting, initiative tests, indoor climbing / bouldering, and the assault course. Having piloted the programme this year, it was very successful with staff and instructors delighted with the efforts of the students.

Students across the year groups have the opportunity to take part in the Duke of Edinburgh awards, which are voluntary awards for 14-25 year olds. To fulfil the requirements of the award, you must help in your community, take part in physical activity, have a willingness to develop and learn new skills, and take part in the expeditions. A number of students have been undertaking the awards over the last few years, and it has helped to develop both their individual and team skills.

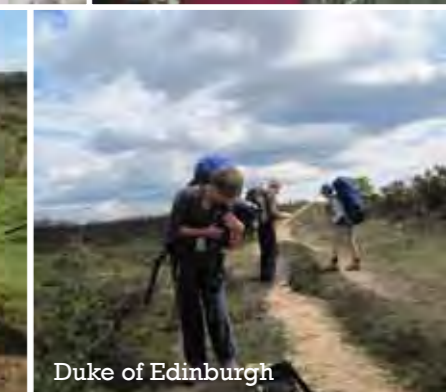
