



# Dunannie Harvest Celebration

1. The Library will be decorated on Tuesday morning, 12<sup>th</sup> October. Noni Needs has kindly offered to co-ordinate the decorating. Please contact her if you would be willing to help.
2. We would appreciate contributions of flowers and foliage on Tuesday morning from those of you who still have these in your garden or even from the hedgerows. However, please no berries or nuts.
3. On Tuesday, 12<sup>th</sup> October, all Year 3 children are asked to bring in apples and other fruit and vegetables or a Harvest basket to decorate the shelves in the Library.

On Wednesday, 13<sup>th</sup> October, children in the Nursery, Reception, Years 1 and 2 are asked to bring in a decorated harvest basket (a shoe box would be suitable) to give to the elderly residents at Ramscote and the Roberts Centre in Portsmouth. The Roberts Centre is a charity offering support and practical help for homeless families and their children. They have asked for non-perishable gifts such as rice, pasta, tins of fruit and vegetables, dried fruit, packets of biscuits and crisps etc. Ramscote are very happy with fruits and vegetables. Please do not send a basket that you need returned. The children often have great fun decorating boxes.
5. We would greatly appreciate help from three or four parents on Wednesday afternoon sorting out the baskets and, if possible, delivering to Ramscote and the Roberts Centre in Portsmouth. We do hope to take a few Year 3 children to Ramscote to share the Harvest Celebration.
