1. The Library will be decorated on Tuesday morning, 11th October. Alex Oldham has kindly offered to co-ordinate the decorating. Please contact her if you would be willing to help.
2. We would appreciate contributions of flowers and foliage on Tuesday morning from those of you who still have these in your garden or even from the hedgerows. However, please no berries or nuts.
3. On Tuesday, 11th October, all Year 3 children are asked to bring in apples and other fruit and vegetables or a harvest basket to decorate the shelves in the Library.

On Wednesday, 12th October, children in the Nursery, Reception, Years 1 and 2 are asked to bring in a decorated harvest basket (a shoe box would be suitable and the children have great fun decorating them) to give to the elderly residents at Ramscoate and the Stonepillow Centre in Chichester. The Stonepillow Centre is a charity offering support and practical help for disadvantaged young people. They have asked for non-perishable gifts such as rice, pasta, spaghetti, porridge oats, biscuits, cereal, sugar, fruit squash, marmite and tinned: meat, ham, tuna, salmon, spaghetti, ravioli, tomatoes, sweetcorn, carrots, potatoes, mix veg, baked beans, chickpeas, kidney beans, borlotti beans, cannellini beans, curry, chilli, fruit, custard, evaporated milk, rice pudding, Ramscoate are very happy with fruit and vegetables. Please do not send a basket that you need returned.
