CAMBRIDGE ENGLISH PROGRAMME (CUP)

This scheme of work is designed for EAL students working at CEFER levels A1, A2, and A2 (KET). It has a comprehensive collection of activities designed to develop the four areas of EAL. Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing. Including workbooks and computer based activities.



HEADWAY ENGLISH PROGRAMME (OUP)
